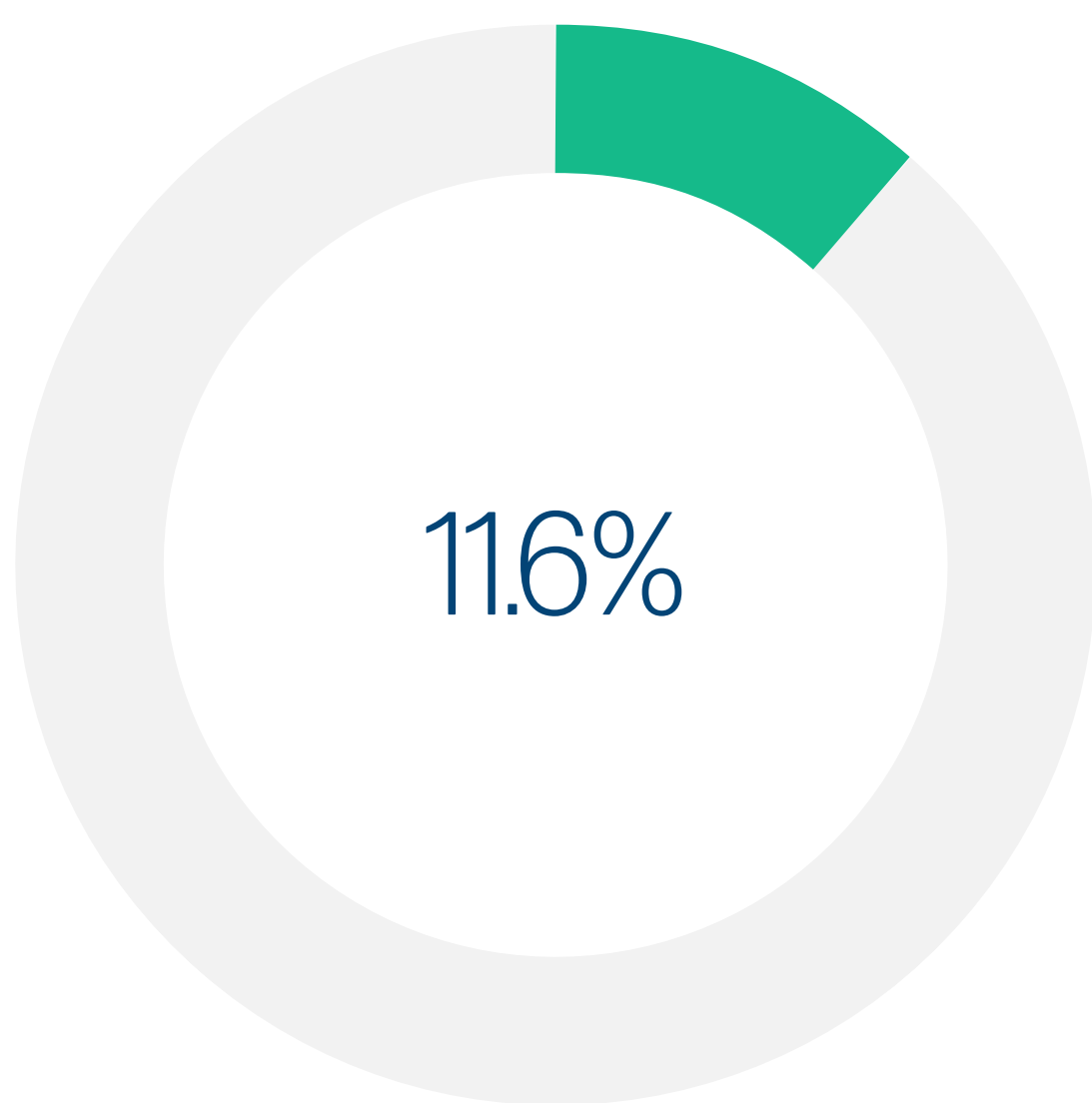


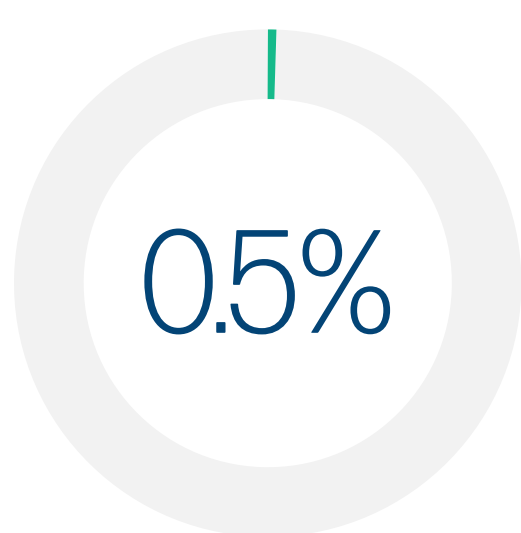
# Prevalence Rate of Permanent Hearing Loss in the U.S.

These data **do not** include people with slight hearing loss or hearing loss in only one ear.

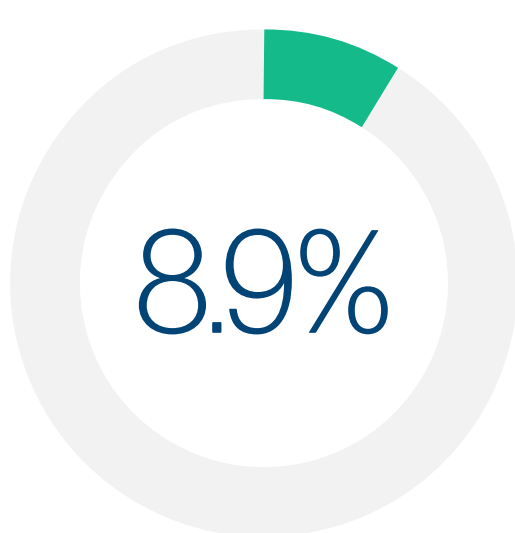

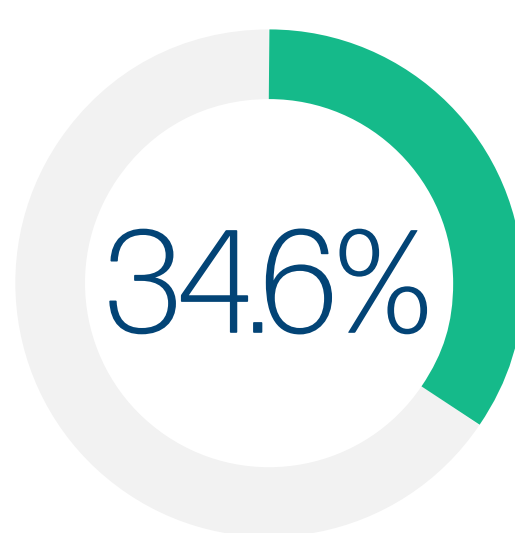

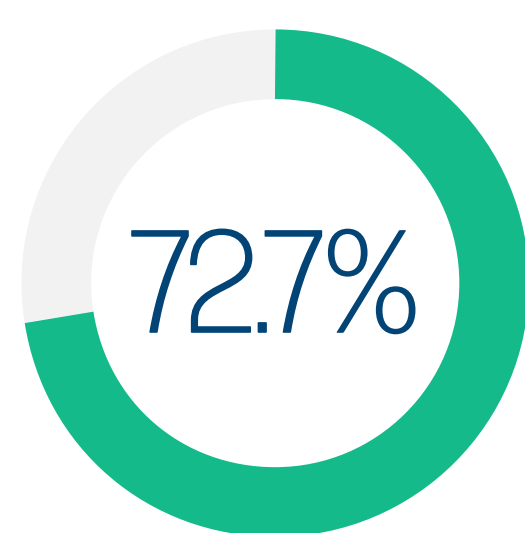
AGES 35-64

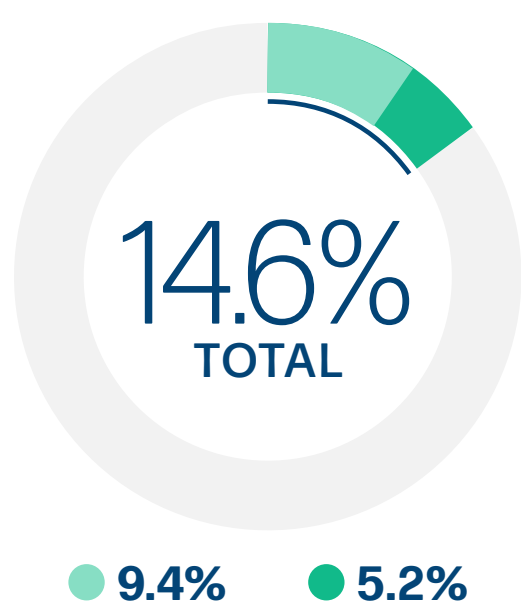

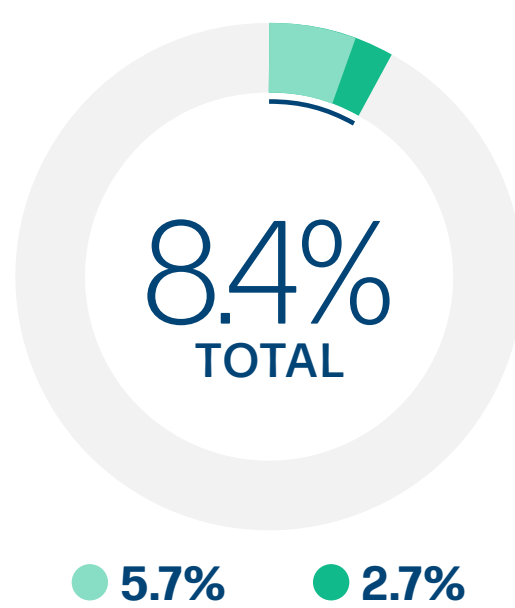

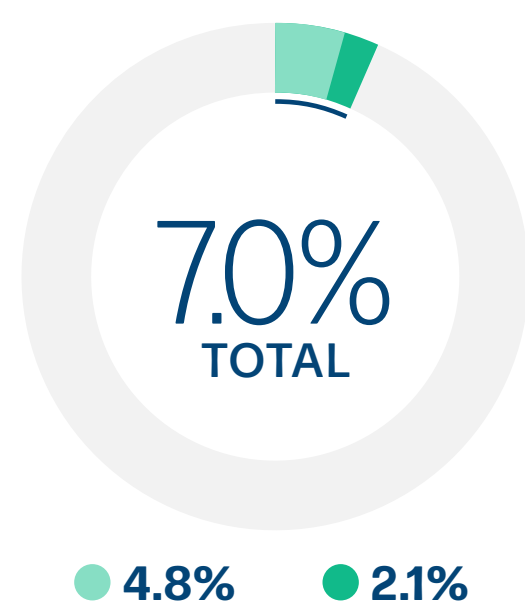

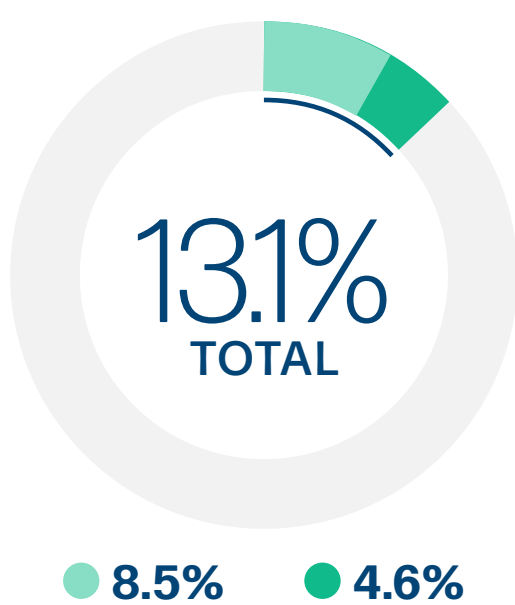
